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# LUNARIN - "INTO THE ETHER"

**Singapore, 15 July 2018** - After a 6-year hiatus, Lunarin will be releasing a 3-track EP titled "Into the Ether". Moving away from their previous DIY ethos, the band enlisted renowned producer David Bottrill to mix and engaged Grammy winning mastering engineer Adam Ayan to master the project.

The EP will be available for preorder on 1 October 2018 and will be released digitally on 15 October 2018 on all digital platforms, including iTunes, Spotify and Bandcamp. As part of an ongoing collaboration with artist Clare Lee, the band will be performing live at the Substation on 15 December 2018.



Clocking at over 23 minutes, the EP is a return to the band's heavy, progressive roots and a response to the rising intolerance and cynicism in society that is threatening the core of human decency today. Few would have expected the band to return. Busy with day jobs and struggling in their roles as parents, there would have been no reason for the trio, consisting of Linda Ong (bass, vocals), Ho Kah Wye (guitars) and Loo Eng Teck (drums, vocals), to release new material again, if not for the fact that the music has been bleeding, festering and growing for the last 6 years before finally breaking free.

It was not a peaceful hiatus.

Humanity's rapid descent has given rise to a grieving process that few people can comprehend. These songs are a collection of that grief. From the raw blistering anger and betrayal in "Rage", the heartbreaking resignation of death and lost in "Bruises" to the apocalyptic destruction in "The Flood", these songs are intended to be a testament to power - power when it has been denied, abused, lost and when it must be regained.
